You came to Berlin as a refugee and want to become integrated as quickly as possible?  
You're motivated and keen to work, but have no idea how to break into Berlin's job market?

ARRIVO BERLIN is an initiative by the state of Berlin that supports you on the way to initial job training and employment.

Whether you already have work experience, want to get it recognized and are looking to find work quickly, or whether you want to train for a job because you know how important it is in Germany to have accredited qualifications – we have the right solution for you.

### ARRIVO BERLIN

- assists refugees on their path to gainful employment and helps them develop their potential
- advises you on job qualifications
- finds you traineeships and jobs in companies
- provides support during your training

Our goal is to bring refugees and Berlin-based companies together and to help both sides ensure that refugees are integrated successfully at work.

For refugees, we have **orientation projects**:

- PRACTICE WORKSHOPS – to help people discover their talents while performing practical work

We also offer **consulting and support**:

- JOB COACHING: secure your future – with vocational training
- PATHWAYS TO JOB QUALIFICATIONS: individual advice and support for refugees with work experience

There are also projects with **industry-specific offers**:

- CONSTRUCTION: lay a sound economic foundation – with a job in construction
- HEALTH: serving society – healthcare and nursing professions
- HOSPITALITY: a career as a host – training and employment in the hotel and gastronomy industry
- RINGPRAKTIKUM®: opening doors to job qualifications – come and get hands-on experience
- SANITARY, HEATING and AIR-CONDITIONING TECHNOLOGY: protect the environment, use cutting-edge technology – as a professional in the sanitary, heating and air-conditioning industry
- SOCIAL: work with and for people – jobs for cool heads and warm hearts

We also have a project **for companies that want to train refugees**:

- SERVICE OFFICE FOR BUSINESSES: good business links – for training and employing refugees

You can take part if you

- have a knowledge of German equivalent to or higher than B1 and have received a sound school education
- are willing to participate regularly and actively in the courses.
